TWO BERGMANN PROJECTS WIN PRESTIGIOUS AWARDS

Rochester / Buffalo, NY – February 10, 2011 – Two recently completed area construction projects have been honored by the American Public Works Association. The annual regional awards promote excellence in the management and administration of public works projects by recognizing the partnership between the managing agency and participating consultants. The two awards are:

2010 Project of the Year – Transportation Projects (\$5-\$25 Million) category

The Sea Breeze Drive / NY 590 Reconstruction Project features four “modern” roundabouts, new custom street lighting, landscaping, fencing, trails and parking areas over a two mile stretch of roadway. The \$14 million project truly gives a new face and “grand entrance” feel to the corridor as well as a safer more sustainable design. Project Owner – Town of Irondequoit.

2010 Project of the Year – Historic Restoration / Preservation category

Restoration of the Route 198 over Delaware Avenue Bridge in Buffalo, NY was a two year, \$2.2 million rehabilitation of the historic bridge which was one of the largest and most visible historic stone masonry rehabilitation projects in the Region. Project Owner – NYS DOT (Region 5).
